# 1. Videomaking with Federico Peixoto (Costa Rica)

12 may at 10-13 workshops @Officine Fotografiche – via libetta 1 Cost: €30 or €25 if combined with another workshop on the same day

PLAN: -the cinematic language -framing and composition -the 180 degrees rule -guerrilla filming

NOTES: Federico is specialized in hip hop documentaries and music videos, he built his career around the street world and filming in difficult conditions often finding himself having to organize the work entirely alone that's why talking about guerrilla filming: useful tips for all levels of preparation.

## **TEACHER'S BIO:**

Costa Rican Filmmaker and video producer, promoted Hip Hop culture since early 2000's. His filmmaking career started in the early 90's. He founded in the mid 90's Gafeto TV documenting different types of underground cultural expressions from Costa Rica, but he documented too international artists like Ephniko, Rxnde Akozta, Myka 9, Asheru , DJ Lord (Public Enemy/Cypress Hill), Sean Paul. He has co-organize events like Griot Collective, the 1st Graffiti National Convention, Buscando la Raíz and in 2009 the Costa Rican tour Manifiesto Urbano, starting his DJ career, since then he has staged with artists as: DJ Muggs from Cypress Hill, Mad Professor, Pato Machete, Lil Suppa, Akapellah, Portavoz, Myka 9. He Co- funded, host and DJ the Hip Hop radio show: La Ofensiva (2013-19). He directed the documentary "Tlacuilos"that narrates the Graffiti scene in Central America, it was shooted for two decades that I now doing world tour.

His love for cinema started when his grandmother worked at an art house Cinema and took Philip along to watch films while babysitting. His independent films always have Humanitarian themes. His first recognition came when he shot a short film on a Flip cam in Kurdistan 2011 and the film was screened at the Duhok International Film Festival and nominated in San Diego Kurdish Youth Film festival. In 2014 he won the Samsung Short film competition at The Dubai International Film Festival. After that he won the Silver Act Responsible award in Cannes for a UN Female Rights awareness campaign in 2015. With his new short films "The Moonlight Rider", "SHE" and Hoody Man, he has been nominated and won 15 awards Internationally

André Grekhov, who is known as Drosha, was born and raised in Russia where he first found his love for the hip-hop culture. When he moved to the Netherlands in his teenage years, the journey as a b-boy took off and he has since then dived into researching, learning, and creating within several styles. He has been competing, teaching, performed and judging in countless events and has received awards from Oranje Fonds, Fonds Cultuur Participatie, and Prince Bernard Culture Fund. He became the world champion in Experimental 2012 at Juste Debout in Paris and is since five years back organizing the experimental festival Open Your Mind. Drosha is also an artistic director and is currently working with Don't Hit Mama 20-year anniversary tour.
